Mickaboo has never hatched an egg in all the time I've been involved. People surrender eggs from time to time with juveniles they surrender and they have never been viable, ever. We don't incubate them and we certainly don't spend funds trying to hatch eggs!

same with eggs from aviary nests. Never viable. I've had volunteers insist I take them home just in case. Never been viable, nothing has ever hatched, then they are discarded. They are not incubated.

Dr Luehman was given a full term egg in March with juvenile GCCs that were surrendered and the contents were not viable. The juveniles also died.

Enough with Melaine's rumor mill website claims.

Now, have Mickaboo adopters had oops babies ? Yes, plenty. You want to point fingers at them? Or are your crosshairs very firmly pointed at certain people?
